REPORT ON THE RESULTS OF THE 2022 SURVEY

THE OVERALL RESULTS OF THE QUESTIONNAIRE «TEACHER THROUGH THE EYES OF STUDENTS- 2022»

Conducting a study

The Center for Sociological Research has been launched since 2010. Monitoring of the quality of educational activities of the university is carried out on an ongoing basis.




Figure 1 - The questionnaire «Teacher through the eyes of students» at the end of each semester in the Univer system

The questionnaire «Teacher through the eyes of students» is conducted at the end of each semester and allows you to get effective feedback on each discipline, as well as an overall assessment of the pedagogical activity of each teacher. The purpose of the survey is to evaluate the effectiveness of courses and the quality of teaching at the university. The survey is conducted in the corporate network of the university «Univer» in the account of each student (Fig.1). It will be held in 2021-2022. The survey was conducted from 11/25/2021 to 12/19/2021 (following the results of the autumn semester) and from 03/29/2022 to 04/17/2022 (following the results of the spring semester).

According to the results of the 2021-2022 survey, **13636** students took part in the survey – 67.7% (of the contingent of students of the 1st-3rd year of bachelor's degree and 1st year of master's degree undergoing theoretical training)






Figure 2 - Structure of the survey «Teacher through the eyes of students» – 2022

The questionnaire contains 14 questions and provides an opportunity to evaluate courses and the quality of teaching according to various criteria (Figure 2). As part of the survey, scaling is used for all questions on a traditional scale from 1 to 5.0, where 1.0 means the lowest level and 5.0 means the highest.

Rating scale:

- 5 points quality is ALMOST ALWAYS manifested;
- 4 points quality is OFTEN manifested;
- 3 points quality is manifested by 50%
- 2 points quality is RARELY manifested
- 1 point the quality is practically non-existent.


The assessment is formed relative to each course.


In general, the university received an assessment of **2287** disciplines in all faculties and specialties.


MAIN RESULTS:











78.66% of the surveyed students confidently recommend the courses studied in the spring semester of 2021-2022 academic year to other students.

According to the faculties, the highest and lowest result (positive assessment and recommendation for study):

89% of students of the Faculty of Law. 46.79% - Faculty of Medicine and Health

According to the results of the survey, 13,636 students evaluated the work of 2,410 teachers.

Including 13 foreign specialists, invited processors at 10 departments (from 3.5 to 5.0). The average score is 4.62.

All university teachers:

5.0 – **13,73%** (331 teachers)

4.99 – 4.50 – **68,92%** (1661 teachers)


4.49 - 4.00 - 11,99% (289 teachers)

3.99 - 3.00 - 4.85% (117 teachers)

2.99 - 1.00 - 0.49% (12 teachers)

The average grade of teaching staff by faculty ranges from 4.43 (Faculty of Medicine and Health) to 4.81 (Faculty of Law).

The average score at the university is **4.68.**



The number of teachers (with a score below 3.0 points) at the university is 12.

The percentage of low grades of teaching staff decreased by almost 2 times in comparison with the 2020-2021 academic year.
