Name	"Social integration and access to basic services for citizens of third countries" Horizon Europe - MIF-2020-AG-CALL-02
Relevance	In recent years, the social integration of third-country nationals (GTS) has been a key priority for the EU and its member States. However, persistent gaps in access to basic services indicate that additional measures are needed to support integration.
Objective	This project contributes to the ongoing efforts to overcome the social vulnerability of third country nationals (GTS) by focusing on four member States from different EU regions: Belgium, Germany, Hungary and Spain. It is designed around a number of activities aimed at identifying and reducing existing barriers to access to services through a transversal and multi-sectoral approach covering five main policy areas: health, housing, education, employment and social security. In accordance with the EU Action Plan for Integration and Inclusion for 2021-2027, it is considered that ensuring inclusion for all and targeted support requires a comprehensive approach. Consequently, the project's actions meet the interests of legislators in further improving existing standards on access to basic services, as well as directly involving front-line practitioners, civil society organizations and migrants.
Tasks	 Raising awareness of migrants about their social rights and organizations and institutions that are ready to provide guidance in the process of obtaining various basic services. Ensuring effective access of migrants to public services by training service providers and informing them about the specific needs of migrants. Cooperation with civil society organizations to provide them with the necessary skills to support third-country nationals (GTS) and facilitate mutual learning and transnational cooperation. Informing legislators about best practices and offering individual guidance on improving the adequacy of public services for diverse population groups.
Expected and achieved results	 Data are provided on the problems faced by citizens of third countries in terms of social integration and access to basic services; □ contributed to the academic discourse on social integration, especially in the context of student communities and educational institutions.
