

Brief information about the project

Title	AP19678348 "The collapse of the Russian Empire and the revival of Kazakh statehood: a historical and legal analysis"
Relevance	<p>A new reading of the pages of the history of Kazakh statehood. The gradual declassification of archival materials in the country and their involvement in scientific circulation will open up new facets of the history of Kazakhstan's ascent to state independence.</p> <p>The relevance of the project is still due to the lack of a special monographic study covering in chronological order the period of the revival of sovereign statehood, starting from the second decade of the twentieth century and up to the present. Therefore, there is an obvious need for historical and legal reproduction of a complete picture of Kazakhstan's ascent to state independence in the process of transformation of state power from autonomy to a modern democratic state in the form of a presidential republic.</p>
Objective	: Taking into account the lack of systematic research and the growing disparaging expressions about the Kazakh statehood on the part of some foreign politicians, to study the history of the revival of the Kazakh statehood in an objective form, dividing it into periods of autonomy before and after the October Revolution, the Soviet form of government, the creation of an independent state and the modern modernization process.
Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - to study and summarize the theoretical conclusions, hypotheses, and suggestions of previous research on this topic; - to make extensive use of published archival sources, while simultaneously searching for archival materials that are not yet involved in scientific circulation; - to analyze the regulatory framework of events related to different periods of the revival of Kazakh statehood, as well as decisions of the Communist Party, to a large extent state-building vectors; - identify historical prerequisites for the emergence of autonomies on the territory of Kazakhstan on the eve and after the October Revolution in the former Russian Empire; - study the features of the transformation of the Kazakh ASSR into a union republic within the USSR; - highlight the political prerequisites for the proclamation of state independence of Kazakhstan; - characterize the process of desovietization of the state and the transition to democratic principles of state life; - show the role of constitutional reforms in the modernization of the structure and activities of state bodies; - to substantiate scientific hypotheses about the directions of development of a sovereign state - the Republic of Kazakhstan.
Expected and achieved results	<p>During the project implementation, the following results will be achieved:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a new reading of the pages of the history of the Kazakh statehood was carried out. The gradual declassification of archival materials taking place in the country and their involvement in scientific circulation will open up new facets of the history of Kazakhstan's ascent to state independence; - a special monographic study has been prepared and published, covering

	<p>in chronological order the period of the revival of sovereign statehood, starting from the second decade of the twentieth century and up to the present;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - an objective historical and legal study of the holistic picture of Kazakhstan's ascent to state independence in the process of transformation of state power from autonomy to a modern democratic state in the form of a presidential republic; - an objective study of the idea of reviving Kazakh statehood, which has dominated the minds of leading representatives of the Kazakh people since the disappearance of the Kazakh Khanate from the political map of the world; - an answer to many questions is given. current issues related to the revival of the Kazakh statehood, which have not been answered to this day; - the legal foundations of the desovietization of power and the transition to a market economy are considered, new knowledge about the process of the revival of the Kazakh statehood is introduced into scientific circulation and public consciousness.; - from the standpoint of legal science, based on the study of new archival documents and materials, the activities of the Autonomous Republic of Alash and its government "Alash-Orda" will be re-evaluated. At the same time, emphasis will be placed on their commitment to the ideas of unitarianism and parliamentarism in the daily practice of state, socio-economic and socio-cultural life of Kazakh society. - a new conclusion is made about the status of Kazakhstan in the Soviet federation, which essentially turned out to be a neo-colony, which appeared in a disguised form continuation of the Russian Empire, only with the replacement of the metropolis, that is, the beneficiary, from the royal court to the highest nomenclature of the CPSU. - a detailed description of the partocracy as a political regime, under which the Soviet bodies called state bodies were not really such, since they were completely subordinated to party committees, was carried out. The mechanism of imposing the will of the party on the governing structures of society will be described. - the role of the triad in the development of Kazakhstan is highlighted in a new way: rule of law – market economy – civil society. - scientific hypotheses about options for modernizing the state in terms of transforming the forms of state government and optimizing the system of administrative and territorial division of the country in the foreseeable future will be substantiated.
