REGULATIONS ON THE STUDENT SCIENTIFIC SOCIETY

I. General provisions

1.1. This Regulation on the student scientific society "Ecologist-jurist (hereinafter - the Regulation) defines the goals and objectives of the society, the procedure for its organization, conduct, summing up.

II. Goals and objectives of the creation of the student scientific society

- 1. The Student Scientific Society is a voluntary organization of students who have expressed a desire to master the skills of conducting scientific research and successfully combine such activities with studies.
- 2. The student scientific society is a structural unit of the student scientific society of the university.
 - 3. The main objectives of the student scientific society are:
 - formation of students' interest and need for scientific creativity;
- development of creative thinking, scientific independence, improvement of internal organization, conscious attitude to learning, deepening and consolidation of knowledge gained in the learning process.
 - 4. The main tasks of the student scientific society:
- ensuring the active participation of students in scientific conferences, competitions for the best scientific work, scientific seminars;
- formation of students' interest in scientific creativity, teaching methods and ways to independently solve scientific problems in the field of environmental research and work skills in research teams;
- assistance to students in mastering the methodology and skills of conducting independent scientific research and developing scientific problems;
- exchange of experience in organizing and conducting scientific work among members of student scientific society s;
- training of the reserve of scientific and scientific-pedagogical personnel from among the most capable, active and successful students;
- identifying the most gifted and talented students, using their creative and intellectual potential to solve urgent problems of improving the effectiveness of the educational process.

III. Leadership of the student scientific society

- 1. For direct scientific guidance of the work of the society, the head of the department is appointed a scientific supervisor.
 - 2. Scientific director of the student scientific society:
 - organizes the work of the society;
- develops the work plan of the society for the academic year and submits it for approval at a meeting of the department;
- selects the candidate of the chairman of the society and proposes it for approval at the meeting of the society;
- works with the members of the society, taking into account their interests, individual abilities and inclinations;
- together with the head of the department, determines the topics of scientific research and presentations by members of the society at scientific conferences;

- provides general scientific guidance to the students' works, assists the members of the society in choosing and clarifying the issues of the topic of scientific work, drawing up a research plan, selecting literature, etc.;
- selects the works performed by students to participate in competitions for the best scientific work and submits them to the cathedral and academic stages of this competition;
 - organizes discussion of student scientific papers at the department;
- petitions for the encouragement of students who actively participate in the work of the society.
- 3. To carry out organizational work and account for the activities of the student scientific society, the chairman of the society is elected from among the students (for a period of one year).

If there are more than 15 students in the society, the secretary of the society can be elected to help the chairman.

- 4. Chairman of the student scientific society:
- together with the supervisor, develops a work plan and keeps a journal of the work of the society for the academic year;
- on the recommendation of the supervisor, provides preparation of reports and speeches at scientific conferences, as well as at meetings of the society;
- promptly informs the members of the society about the activities of scientific work at the department, faculty, university;
 - keeps records of students' scientific papers submitted for competitions;
- provides assistance to the scientific director of the society in preparing a report on the work of the student scientific society for the academic year.
- 5. The head of the department provides assistance to the work of the student scientific society, submits issues related to research topics to the meeting of the department, attracts teaching staff as scientific supervisors of students participating in the competition for the best scientific papers. The department nominates the best scientific works of students for participation in the academic stage of the competition.

IV. Organization of work of the student scientific society

- 1. Meetings of student scientific society s are held at least twice a semester. The scientific director of the society informs the members of the Council of People's Commissars in advance about the dates and times of the meetings. At the meetings of the society, the issues of teaching students the basics of the methodology of conducting scientific research are considered, the results of the scientific work of the members of the society (scientific articles, abstracts and competitive papers, etc.) are discussed. The plans of the society are maintained throughout the academic year.
 - 2. The main forms of scientific work of students:
- participation in the implementation of planned scientific works of the department;
- development of scientific reports, reports and abstracts on topical issues, presentation of them at meetings of student scientific society s, scientific seminars and conferences;
 - preparation of publications based on research results;

• participation in competitions for the best scientific papers.

V. The rights and obligations of the members of the student scientific society

- 1. Any student who successfully masters the curriculum (who does not have unsatisfactory grades at the end of the semester of study) and who has expressed a desire to participate in research work on the subject of the department can become a member of the student scientific society. Admission is carried out on a voluntary basis on the basis of an oral application from the applicant.
 - 2. Members of the student scientific society have the right to:
 - participate in the planned activities of the club;
 - receive information about the organization of students' scientific work;
- submit their works for participation in the competition for the best scientific works of students;
 - publish the best scientific papers and speeches in university publications;
 - 3. The members of the student scientific society are obliged to:
- regularly attend meetings of the student scientific society during the academic year;
- to speak at the meetings of the society and scientific conferences with scientific reports and reports;
- to carry out the instructions of the head of the society related to the organization of scientific work;
 - develop a selected topic of scientific work.

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
