



Management system structure






Cost management system

A cost management system (CMS) is a targeted, multi-level system, where the object of management is the organization's costs, and the subject of cost management is the management subsystem



Basic elements of the CMS

- organizational structure
- management processes
- management methodology






Cost management system

- Brigade


Servicing cost centers:

Conditional cost centers – cost item, integrated cost item, economic element




Enterprise management by function
