REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstracts should be submitted to the secretariat by email at kaznusslab@gmail.com by **August 15th**, 2024 at the latest. The main requirements for abstract design are:

- The abstract should not exceed 7 pages in Microsoft Word 2010 or later.
- Place the title centered (in capital letters, bold font, size 12).
- Below the title, include the author's surname and initials (lowercase letters, bold, size 11).
- After the last name, include the organization you are representing, city, and country (lowercase, bold, 11 pt). Include the email address of corresponding author below (italics, 10 pt). Abstracts must include the results of your research (graphs, tables, or photographs).
- Page parameters: top margin - 2 cm, bottom margin - 2 cm, left margin - 3 cm, right margin - 1.5 cm. Use Times New Roman font size 12, single line spacing, paragraph indentation 1 cm, portrait orientation, no headers or footers, text aligned left.
- Design of the literature, table, and figure captions in accordance with the sample, font - 10 pt.

Based on the results of the forum there will be published in conference proceedings if the author puts the corresponding tick in the registration card. **This is an optional function.**

The limited number of papers (new unpublished materials) selected by the committee and presented at the conference will be published in [Recent Contributions to Physics](#) indexed in Web of Science or the [International Journal of Mathematics and Physics](#) indexed in Web of Science and Scopus. The journal requirements can be found [here](#) and [here](#).

The working language of the forum is *English*.

KEY DATES

August 15, 2024 – deadline for submitting abstracts

September 1, 2024 – notification of abstracts acceptance

September 15, 2024 – publication of the final program of the conference

October 30, 2024 – notification of selected papers acceptance for publication in selected journals.

For local participants registration fee is 15000 tenge, for foreign participants registration fee is \$100. For master's degree students, upon presentation of a certificate from the university in English (with a stamp), participation in the conference is free of charge.

Only horizontal lines should be used within a table, to distinguish the column headings from the body of the table, and immediately above and below the table. Tables must be embedded into the text and not supplied separately. Below is an example which the authors may find useful.

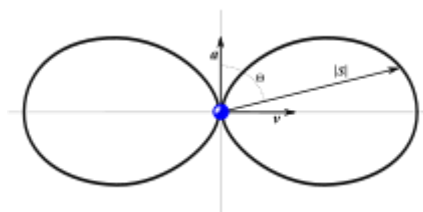


Fig. 1. - The radiation pattern of the dipole emitter in polar coordinates
