Brief information about the project

Semirechensk region - as part of the communication of the Russian empire (1865-1917)
The emergence and introduction of communication tools such as post and telegraph in the region, and the growing need for their services make the study relevant. The novelty of the project is that for the first time in the pre-revolutionary Semirechensk region, the system of mass communication was comprehensively studied. Based on new archive documents, the post-telegraph service of Semirechensk region, the social and economic situation of its employees, the scope of their activities are comprehensively considered, and tables are compiled based on comparative-historical methods. In addition, because of geoinformation mapping, the location of post and telegraph institutions in Semirechensk region, a map of the main road routes of postal tracts is created.
Purpose of the project is to study the activities of postal and telegraph institutions and the organization of postal services in the Semirechensk region from 1865 to 1917.
 Development of features of management of postal and telegraph departments at the level of all Russia and the world, in the region in the 19th-19th centuries. Studying the experience of domestic researchers of the postal and telegraph service; In the study of the history of the Russian Empire and the postal and telegraph service on the territory of Kazakhstan, the study of new theories in the field of domestic and Western historiography, social and human sciences, anthropological sciences.

	The 1875 postal routes were mapped using GIS mapping
	based on the above-mentioned sources published during the
	period 1777-1901. The map is compiled separately for postal
	routes and stations throughout Kazakhstan and for
	individual regions (south, Semirechye, northeast,
	northwest). The novelty of the proposed project lies in the fact that for
	the first time the system of mass communications of the
	Semirechensk region of the pre-revolutionary period will be
	comprehensively studied. Based on new archival

Regulatory acts, orders, official letters and statistical reports of central and local postal and telegraphic communications institutions, letters from postal and telegraphic departments of the regional administration were used. The status of the employee is determined, which includes such issues as training, hiring, wages, and calendar plan. Some experience of the postal service was considered in a comparative analysis using the example of European countries. In Germany, using the example of Bavaria, Saxony, Württemberg, Hanover, and in the British Empire, the postal service was considered from the perspective of relations with the colonies, including India.
