Relevance	leading trends, genre studies, plot, hero>>The project is aimed at carrying out a multidimensional analysis of modern prose in Kazakhstan as a local cultural phenomenon in the general Kazakhstan literary process.The study of prose in this perspective also allows us to understand the complexity and inconsistency of the
	hermeneutic cultural field and outlines a further perspective of its development in the context of the world literary space of the XX-XXI centuries. The project involves the study of Russian prose of Kazakhstan in recent decades in the context of the development of the all- Kazakhstan modern literary process using innovative information and computer technologies.
Purpose	The goal of the project is to consider the current state of Russian prose in Kazakhstan to identify its leading trends, to identify the genre dominant of the aesthetically significant newest works of Russian and Russian-speaking writers of Kazakhstan. Based on the theory of M.M. Bakhtin about the constant renewal of the genre, to determine the genre range of works that influenced the plot and interpretation of the hero of modern literature.
Objectives	Project objectives: - analysis and interpretation of the poetics of modern Russian prose to identify the genre matrix of a literary text, to understand the functions of significant plot elements in the structure of the narrative, to determine the principles for creating the image of a literary hero of the "modern time".
	- creation of a multifunctional IT product, consisting of an array of scientific information about the Russian and Russian-speaking writer of Kazakhstan and his prose, created in the late 20th-early 21st centuries, with free access to everyone who is interested in the modern literary process;
	 introduction into scientific circulation of works of modern Kazakhstani prose writers in Russian, significant from an aesthetic point of view, previously not studied by modern domestic literary criticism; interpretation of the content of artistic experiments of writers that destroy genre canons;
	 analysis of the creative individuality of the writer of the period under study for the purpose of inclusion in the Bio-Bibliographic Directory; creation in paper and electronic form of the Bio- Bibliographic Directory, which includes articles devoted

	to Russian and Russian-speaking writers of Kazakhstan of the period under study;
	- the use of modern information technologies to

	curriculum in literature;
