Brief information about the project

	the Kazakh thinkers in foreign archives"
Relevance	The idea of the project is aimed at distinguishing the scientific heritage of Kazakh figures in world archives based on sources in the Arabic language and determining their contribution to the field of world science. Since Arabic was the language of international communication in the Middle Ages, sources in Arabic were scattered in archives around the world. Since the middle of the last century, some of the manuscripts related to Kazakh scientists have been obtained, but the majority of them have not yet been studied and have not entered scientific circulation. Therefore, we aimed to fill this gap by systematic research of world-class large archives. The results of the project are closely related not only to the field of Islamic studies, but also to the subjects of data science and history. Therefore, the results of the project allow to look at several areas of
	humanitarian sciences from a new perspective.
Goal	The goal of project is creating an anthology of Kazakh steppe thought based on study of Arabic–language sources, materials, databases stored in archives of various countries and providing bibliographic, brief annotations of works in Islamic world that have important scientific significance.

Tasks	Project Objectives 1. Study of catalogues of library collections of various countries of the world to identify and classify archives storing materials on the Kazakh steppe; 2. Compiling a list of works dedicated to Muslim education in the Kazakh steppe from archives of the world, collecting information about representatives of the Kazakh steppe and their works, determining the historical periodization of data; 3. Systematization of manuscripts in libraries and archives containing information on the history of the formation of religious education in the Kazakh steppe; 4. Analysis of the history of the formation and features of Muslim education through the study of biographical data, the works of Kazakh scientists and the cultural environment that influenced the formation of their personalities on the basis of primary sources from archival collections of different neighboring countries; 5. Collection and analysis of data, materials related to the Kazakh steppe found in archives and library collections of European countries, comparative analysis features of Muslim education, its periodization and development in the steppe conditions of Kazakh identity; 6. Compilation and preparation of a list of manuscripts related
	to the history, education and culture, heritage of scientists and thinkers of the Kazakh steppe on the basis of archival funds of the countries of the far and near abroad; 7. Publication of intermediate results as an article in peer-reviewed foreign and (or) domestic publications recommended by the Committee for Quality Assurance in the Field of Science and Higher Education of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan; 8. Preparing a monograph on the topic "Anthology of Kazakh steppe thought based on Arabic-language sources in world

Dissemination of the results in the scientific circle of

	the heritage of Kazakh thinkers; 3. Rethinking the scientific heritage of the thinkers of the Kazakh steppe and compiling a single catalog based on the data obtained from foreign archives;
	4. Improving methodological approaches to the preparation of textbooks, textbooks and teaching materials for educational institutions in accordance with modern requirements, including the principle of secularism in education and science;
	5. Analyze the history of the formation and development trends of Islamic education in the Kazakh steppe, identify ways to implement Islamic education in Kazakhstan and the role of the results of the analysis in the implementation of these imperatives;
	6. Substantiate the need to create a unified information portal about Islamic education, about centers analyzing the state of Kazakh society and development trends in the religious sphere;
	7. The use of a unified system of data obtained in the course of research to improve the historiographical and scientificmethodological basis for the study of materials related to Islamic education, Islamic studies in Kazakhstan. Achieved Results:
	Based on the study of global catalogs, archives related to the history, religious culture, and personalities of the Kazakh steppe were identified and classified.
	As a result of studying "Tabaqat and Tarazhum" sources, a complete list was compiled, and based on the obtained materials, information about the works of individuals originating from Kazakh lands was analyzed and analyzed.
	Based on research work in archival collections and libraries in Bukhara, Samarkand, Tashkent, Konya, Istanbul, a manuscript list was compiled, and project research was carried out within the topic through documentary analysis of manuscripts. As a result of the interim results, 1 article was published in a
	reviewed domestic publication recommended by the Scientific and Educational Council of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan. As a result of the business trip to Jeddah, information from domestic archival collections was obtained, which will be

	included in the anthology of Kazakh steppe philosophy by systematizing information about the history of the formation of science and education in the Kazakh land and manuscripts from libraries and archives.
