Relevance	The proposed research project aims to apply the sociological tools of
	modern research to measure the religiosity, well-being, and identity of
	kazakhstani youth in a religiously diverse society. At all stages of the
	project, the goal of studying youth as a social construct is correlated
	with the construction of scales, to measure (1) the influence of young
	people's religious orientation on religious beliefs and interactions with
	everyday life; to identify (2) identify statuses and commitment scores;
	to determine (3) key predictors of well-being, such as stress and
	coping, life satisfaction, and faith satisfaction.

Purpose	The goal of the project is to conduct a comparative analysis in the study
	of the youth of Kazakhstan in the context of a new discourse of social
	construction of their religiosity/spirituality, well-being and identity in
	a religiously diverse society and their measurement using various
	scales (including "centrality", "religious overcoming", "perceived
	stress") and questionnaires of "ego-identity" processes and coping
	strategies.
Objectives	1. A comparative analysis of social construction concepts as an
	important methodological tool used in the study of
	religiosity/spirituality, well-being, and identity, taking advantage of
	the sub(disciplines) of the social sciences.
	2. Identification of indicators of the sociological measurement
	of religiosity, well-being and identity of the youth of Kazakhstan.
	3. Identification of dichotomous variables, in assessing
	components of religiosity, well-being, and identity such as
	gender/gender, domestic/public, degree of acceptance/unacceptance
	of beliefs, subjective religiosity, commitment statuses, coping, life and
	faith satisfaction.
	4. Identification of measurement scales and subscales as well as
	measurement and self-assessment measures to examine youth
	religiosity/spirituality, well-being, and identity and conduct a series of
	confirmatory factor analyses to establish measurement invariance.
	5. Analysis of the religious situation in the youth environment
	using the advantages of sociological methodology.
	6. Preparation of methodological tools for sociological research
	on religiousness/spirituality of Kazakhstani youth on the basis of
	benchmarking international research projects and the world's best
	practices. The implementation of this task in volves a pilot study to
	adapt and specify the methodology.

	opportunities to use various questionnaires in assessing the invariance of the measurement of the construct of religiosity/spirituality, well
