Title	AP22682863 «The work of al-Kalkashandi (XV century) «Subh al-asha fi sina at al-insha» as a source of historical geography of the Golden Horde».
Relevance	Within the framework of medieval historiography, the works of Arab geographers and travelers occupy a large place among foreign sources related to various countries. Geographical research among Russian orientalists has not lost its relevance to this day. Current research continues to emphasize the importance of Arabic sources.
Goal	The purpose of the research is translation, source analysis and labor processing. Abu'l-Abbas Ahmad Shihab al-din al-Masri al-Qalqashandi, who served as Secretary of State in Cairo, died in 821 AH (February 8, 1418-27 January 1419). His seven-volume work «Subh Al-asha fi sina at al-insha» is a valuable source of medieval geography of the Golden Horde.

Expected and Achieved Results	<p>Work has been carried out on the systematization, classification and analysis of the work under study, and the project structure has been approved.</p> <p>The review of scientific literature and sources related to the research topic is carried out.</p> <p>Historical data from Eastern sources were grouped, classified and introduced into scientific circulation. In order to implement the research project, from February 11 to February 25, 2025, a scientific trip was conducted to the libraries of the G. Tsereteli Institute of Oriental Studies of Ilyinsky State University and a certificate was obtained. In accordance with the purpose of the business trip, the necessary materials on research topics were sought and identified.</p>
