Zh. Abdiman studied the texts of the solemn ceremony from different perspectives, and a comprehensive analysis led to the identification of their main features in the form of proposed provisions for defense. Each dissertation result is verified and persuasive, supported by numerous examples from 15 Inaugural Addresses

of the presidents of both countries.

It is known that scientific propositions must allow for the essential possibility of refutation and assume specific procedures for their confirmation. In this respect, we have an excellent example of empirical confirmation of the proposed provisions. The study presented by Zh. Abdiman can be classified as an independent scientific work that possesses all the necessary attributes of new theoretical knowledge, an expanded system of valid linguistic facts, convincing argumentation for the propositions, logical integrity and completeness, all presented in a sufficiently reasoned and explicit manner.

All formal requirements for the PhD program of Zh.Abdiman has been successfully completed. The necessary publications are available, and reports and presentations have been delivered at international conferences. It can be rightfully stated that the main provisions of the dissertation are known to the scientific

community.
